



# Juvenile Fire Setter Intervention Program Certification Course

The Juvenile Fire Setter Intervention Program (JFSIP) is a statewide standardized program to provide prevention education/intervention and referrals if warranted for the children and families of Illinois to reduce the frequency and severity of fires set by juveniles. The components of this program are: Identification System, Intake Process, Interview/Screening Strategies, Education/Intervention Services, and Evaluation/Follow-up.

The 2-day certification course provides the tools necessary to complete an intervention according to the NFPA 1035 standards regarding juvenile fire setting. The state certification test is provided at the end of the course.
